


Kew Gardens is London's largest UNESCO World Heritage site, offering unique landscapes, vistas and iconic architecture.

International Summer School

Study at Roehampton for three or six weeks over summer and gain academic credit whilst exploring London. You will live and learn on our beautiful parkland and have access to all the University's support services, as well as your dedicated Roehampton Abroad team.

Our summer modules make the most of our proximity to the city centre, and offer you the chance to experience London from a critical, academic perspective. With London as the backdrop to study, the city functions as a living classroom.

Small class sizes and daily teaching provide a personalised experience and all modules include trips in the city.


You will take one intensive module during the programme, which will be taught over two weeks of in-person learning and one week of online content after you depart campus.

Applicants should:

- Have a minimum 2.8 GPA (out of 4) or equivalent
- Have approval from their home university (where appropriate)
- Be 18 years of age or older
- Have achieved a minimum of IELTS 6.0 or equivalent proof of English Language (where necessary)


